- Nonresident students will only be considered for the grade level and/or school building where capacity has been determined.
- The nonresident student must not currently be under expulsion or long-term suspension from their current school district.
- The nonresident student(s) or the family must provide transportation to and from the assigned school or USD 483 school bus stop.
- Parents/Guardians must consistently get students(s) to school or to the specified USD 483 bus stop, so the student is not late to start the school day. At the conclusion of the school day, they are also to pick up student(s) or meet them at the specified USD 483 bus stop to pick up the student(s). The bus will not wait if parents are not there. Students will be taken back to their school building and parents will be notified.
- When applicable, a new Individualized Education Plan (IEP) will be written upon enrollment.
- Providing false information on this application will result in the disqualification from nonresident enrollment eligibility.
- Parents or guardians of the nonresident student selected for enrollment, including siblings, must acknowledge receipt of acceptance and student placement within (5-7) business days from the notification or the nonresident enrollment may be denied.
- Students selected for nonresident enrollment through the lottery selection process or due to a lack of capacity must reapply each year in which they wish to be considered for nonresident enrollment.

Note: *To maintain attendance at USD 483, students must be in and maintain “good standing” (see district policy on website). Students that do not maintain “good standing” status, may not be allowed to continue their future education in USD 483.*

Acceptance of each student will be determined by the availability of space in classrooms, buildings and/or programs.
